ROGUE TRADERS

Tou may well be one of the millions of viewers shocked by Rogue Traders on BBC1 last year. The series caught some shocking examples of dodgy gardeners, plumbers, roofers and drivelayers on camera as they went about ripping off the public. When it comes to getting work done on your house, finding a good tradesman can prove to be a nightmare.

To steer clear of bad treatment

should only have cost £50. Nine of the traders caught on camera faced prosecution.

According to a survey of London homeowners carried out for a home services website, cowboy tradesmen cost us £865 million a year in botched jobs. One in three homeowners had to employ another tradesman to fix the previous one's mistakes — at an average cost of £256.

£865m cost of rogue builders

ALMOST 10million homeowners have suffered from cowboy tradesmen in the last year, with botched jobs costing more than £865million to put right, a survey has revealed.

More than half of 1,000 homeowners questioned paid cash in hand to avoid VAT charges.

But those who did so are fuelling a 'nationwide boom' in rogues, costing more than £865million a year in repairs, the research found.

One in three homeowners employed another tradesman to correct a previous builder's mistakes, at an average cost of £256 per botched job.

In the past year alone, 68 per cent of

homeowners – just under 10million – have suffered from a cowboy tradesman's botched job.

And 73 per cent have let tradesmen work on their homes without a contract.

Andrew Skipwith of online firm Rated Tradesmen, which conducted the survey, said: 'When it comes to your home you really do only get what you pay for.

'If you go for a cheaper option and don't use reputable tradesmen the deal is likely to backfire.

"You'll end up with shoddy craftsmanship that will undoubtedly cost you more in the long run, through repairs."

Vetting Process:

- Face to Face Meeting
- CRB Basic Check
- A valid Drivers Licence and Vehicle Insurance Document
- Certificate of Public Liability Insurance
- Proof of membership to any Trade Association (e.g., Fensa, IPHE, etc)
- Proof of qualifications (where applicable)
- Proof of statutory qualifications (e.g., Gas Safe Registered, Part P, etc)
- Certificate of Incorporation for Limited Companies
- Certificate of VAT registration document (if applicable)
- 3 references which are subject to verification





Service Charter

Service CHARTER which includes:-

- Contact the customer as soon as possible. It must not be any later than 48 hours from receiving the enquiry.
- Inform the customer immediately if they are unable or unwilling to undertake the proposed work.
- Arrive at the agreed time for appointments and will give advance warning of any unavoidable delay.
- Treat customers with courtesy and respect.
- Supply a written receipt for payments received.
- Deal with any complaints and /or disputes as quickly as possible.




