Why Romania?

- Romania will receive EU Structural and Cohesion funds totalling €74 billion by 2020
- Significant domestic market of 21 million consumers, Bucharest is the sixth largest city in the EU
- The economy is forecast to grow by 3.5% in 2015 and 4.1% in 2016 (DG ECFIN)
- Over the last 10 years Romania has achieved substantial trade growth with the UK; UK exports increased 50% to nearly £1 billion
